The Resurrection of Jesus Offers You God's Power

EPHESIANS 1:18-20

"I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know the hope to which he has called you, the riches of his glorious inheritance in his holy people, and his incomparably great power for us who believe.

EPHESIANS 1:18-20

That power is the same as the mighty strength he exerted when he raised Christ from the dead and seated him at his right hand in the heavenly realms."

PHILIPPIANS 3:10

"I want to know Christ—yes, to know the power of his resurrection and participation in his sufferings, becoming like him in his death,"

What sets Christianity apart is that you are given the power to live for God and do all he asks you to do. All throughout Jesus' ministry you see his power.

Jesus has power over disease, power over nature, power over evil, and even power over death. This same power is available to you.



Dunamis

Paul says that because of the resurrection, you have power available to you, explosive power, like dynamite. Power that can heal your diseases.

Power that can calm the storms in your life. Power over all evil that plagues you. Even power over your death!

The only good way to respond to Jesus on Easter is to trust and follow him. To receive his peace, presence, and power. To live with unshakable hope.
