TALK IT OVER | LESSON 2

Hey parents! Use these questions as a guide to talk over this week's Bible story called **Jesus Visits Mary and Martha** with your child after they've watched this week's Church at Home early childhood video. Remember the Big Idea: *When I'm friends with Jesus, I can learn what is best.*

1. What was your favorite part of the video we just watched?
2. Who is the best friend we'll ever have?
Jesus!
3. Who did what was best in the story today?
Mary did what was best.
4. How did Mary do what was best?
She chose to sit and listen to Jesus. Spending time with Jesus is always the best choice.
5. What are some ways you can be with Jesus?
You can be with Jesus when you: listen to what he says by reading the Bible, talk to him when you pray, make time to go to church even when you have a play date or party, or do what he says in the Bible and make good choices instead of bad choices.
6. What can you do if you don't know what is the best choice?
You can look for an answer in the Bible, ask Jesus when you pray to him, or talk to an adult who loves Jesus to help you know what is best.
7. Take some time to pray with your child. You might pray something like this:
Dear God, thank you for sending Jesus and showing us how to be a good friend. Thank you for loving us so much! Help us to always know what is best. We love you! Amen.
