TALK IT OVER | LESSON 2

Hey parents! Use these questions as a guide to talk over this week's Bible story called **Jesus Visits Mary and Martha** with your child after they've watched this week's Church at Home elementary video. And remember: *When I'm friends with Jesus, I can learn what is important.*

1. What was your favorite part of the video we just watched?
2. How can you tell something is important to someone?
Maybe they spend a lot of time with it or take really good care of it. Maybe they spent a lot of money on it. It's special to them and they talk about it.
3. What did Mary choose that Jesus said was most important?
She chose to spend time with Jesus.
4. Martha was preparing dinner. Is that bad?
No! It's good to cook and clean and get the house ready, but sometimes stopping and just being with Jesus is best! Even though there are lots of good and important things to do, those things should never take the place of spending time with Jesus.
5. Why do you think Jesus says spending time with him is most important?
Jesus is the best friend we could ever ask for. He knows what is best and wants the best for us. It's good to spend time with our friends, but Jesus is our very best friend and can help us in so many ways, so it's important to always make time for him too!
6. How can you be with Jesus and make him the most important?
You can listen to what he says by reading the Bible, talking to him when you pray, make church a priority every week, and always do what God says in the Bible. If you aren't sure what is the most important choice, look for the answer in the Bible, ask God through prayer, and talk to a parent or adult who you trust and who loves Jesus, too!
7. When we make Jesus the most important, we are telling him we love him and he is our friend. Take some time right now to pray and talk to Jesus.
