TALK IT OVER | LESSON 5

Hey parents! Use these questions as a guide to talk over this week's Bible story called **Jesus Washes His Disciples' Feet** with your child after they've watched this week's Church at Home elementary video. And remember: *When I'm friends with Jesus, he shows me how to be a good friend.*

1. What was your favorite part of the video we just watched?
2. Who is your best friend? What do you like about your best friend?
3. Who is the best example of a good friend?
Jesus!
4. What did Jesus mean when he said, "Do as I have done to you"?
Jesus told the disciples to be a good friend like him. In the Bible story, Jesus showed what it looked like to be a good, loving friend by washing his disciples' feet.
5. Does being a good friend mean washing people's feet?
Sometimes. But Jesus shows us that being good friends means sometimes doing things that might be hard or dirty or surprising to show love and humility to people.
6. What does humility mean?
Humility means putting other people first.
7. How can you show humility and be a good friend to others like Jesus?
You can ask your friends how you can help them, pay attention to their feelings, pray for them, help take care of them if they are hurt or sad, make something special for them, let them go first, or share your food or snacks with them.
8. Jesus went above and beyond when he washed his disciples' feet – a job no one wanted to do. Is there something you don't want to do that would show someone you're a good friend?
Helping pick up toys when you leave a friend's house, offering to help a friend do their chores, walking the neighbor's dog or taking out their trash. When we do the things we don't want to do, we are showing our friends we love them the way Jesus loves.
