



LifeGroup Mission Lead Role Description

PURPOSE:

To give leadership within their LifeGroup for the value of “Engage Missionally”

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- To partner with the LifeGroup leader to vision and bring continual focus for their group to “Get Out”. This person should have a strong desire to take the “learning” to “doing” in practical, hands-on ways.
- To provide resources that educate the group as to why they serve together (inward focus).
- Assessment of the group’s skills and abilities, to determine their spiritual makeup and determine the best serving opportunities (inward focus).
- To execute a plan for the group to serve consistently as part of their LifeGroup rhythm, and to facilitate group discussions as to ways and places to serve (from inward to outward focus).
- To include a missional focus consistently in the LifeGroup meetings through updates, discussion, connecting the dots of application and prayer.
- To attend leadership training (most often a leadership cluster) when the content directly applies to mission (about twice / year).
- To connect with the LifeGroup Mission Director and team for further resourcing and effectiveness.
